Mayor and Council:

There are a couple of things worth noting from Richard Thompson's daily Covid report. The first is the fact that Hawaii has relaxed their travel restrictions. I traveled to Hawaii in Mid February and thought they had really done it right. There is a new vaccine coming soon which should be interesting as well,

Next please see the screenshot provided in Richard Thompson's daily report which shows various locals and the vaccination rates.

The Dillingham Census Area (including Dillingham) stands at 57% of the eligible population with at least one dose of vaccine. The State of Alaska Vaccination Dashboard does not currently break out communities from the Census Area or Boroughs. However, a request on 27 May 2021 to SOA DHSS via the Dillingham Public Health Clinic for breakout of Dillingham's vaccination status separate from the Dillingham Census Area indicated that at that time 61% of the eligible population in Dillingham had received at least one dose of vaccine.

Notice there are areas in the Region with even higher vaccination rates.

The Mayor and I are attempting to set up a meeting with the Hospital Medical Staff to talk about our disposition and then I need to think about next steps regarding whether or not to continue the City EOC. You will also find attached a memo from Richard Thompson that I asked him to prepare, basically a list of things that need to be done if and when we stand down the Emergency Operations Center; and which tasks will need to continue. Given the fact that the State of Alaska has relaxed requirements and many states are opening up we need to prepare to do the same.

Richard continues his work as scheduled. The travel forms continue to come in and phone calls are fielded by his office. There was one case reported here in Dillingham, according to the State of Alaska, on 5-20-2021. The number of cases in the region appear to be drastically tapering off as vaccinations increase. At some point we will need to decide when to open city hall. My plan is to open city hall when all employees are vaccinated which should happen soon.
